## 1. Overview

The International Ecoagriculture Conference and Practitioners' Fair was convened from 27 September to 1 October 2004 at the World Agroforestry Centre in Nairobi, Kenya. The purpose of the Conference was to assess the state of ecoagriculture systems and practices, and to develop a strategy to promote and support ecoagricultural development worldwide. The meeting brought together 210 of the world's leading innovators in ecoagriculture: community leaders, farmers, conservationists, policymakers, researchers, technical advisors, land-use planners, business and industry. Conference organization was led by Ecoagriculture Partners, with generous support from a broad group of ecoagriculture collaborators.

This volume, Volume 4, accompanies the main Conference report (Volume 1) and provides details of programmes from the main Conference and Community Shamba preparatory meetings; conference sponsors; full participant contact details; and a list of ecoagriculture initiatives developed by Conference participants. ## 2. Main Conference Programme

The Conference programme was structured on a 'What', 'So What', 'Now What' methodology:

- **What** is the current state of ecoagriculture?
- **What** are the differences and diversity in opinions, ideologies, methodologies and approaches?
- **So what** are the opportunities and challenges to achieving ecoagriculture objectives, and on-going initiatives already making a contribution?
- **Now what** critical actions need to be taken to build on opportunities and overcome barriers?

Group discussions formed the central activity of the Conference, primarily focused on **four themes**:



**Theme 1: Understanding Ecoagriculture** – the Scientific Foundations



**Theme 2: Managing Ecoagriculture** at a Landscape Scale



**Theme 3: Valuing Ecoagriculture** for Livelihoods and Business



**Theme 4: Mobilising Community Ecoagriculture**

Programmes for each theme ran in parallel from Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> Sept – Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September. Outcomes and recommendations from each theme group were presented in plenary on the morning of Friday 1<sup>st</sup> October. Integral elements of the Conference programme also included the Community Shamba preparatory meetings, plenary presentations, Farming discussion groups, mid-week field trips and a closing Policy Forum.

### **3. Community Shamba Preparatory Meeting: 25-26<sup>th</sup> September Program Outline**

The Community Shamba played an integral role in the Conference, supporting the broad engagement of grassroots innovators and maximizing opportunities for knowledge exchange amongst field practitioners. The purpose of the preparatory meetings were to facilitate sharing of community stories and ecoagriculture practices while familiarizing participants with Conference themes and objectives

Over 60 practitioners from 24 countries participated. The community space provided a forum for group discussions, poster displays and the showcasing of products from community based ecoagriculture systems and enterprises.

#### **Desired outcomes from the Preparatory meetings were to:**

- Recognize community successes in ecoagriculture, share knowledge of these successes and of the obstacles to mobilization and scaling up, and create strategies to impact policy at all levels;
- Establish key issues, messages, and approaches to integrating community perspectives and needs across Themes and Working Groups;
- Summarise and articulate community goals for presentation to the main Conference.

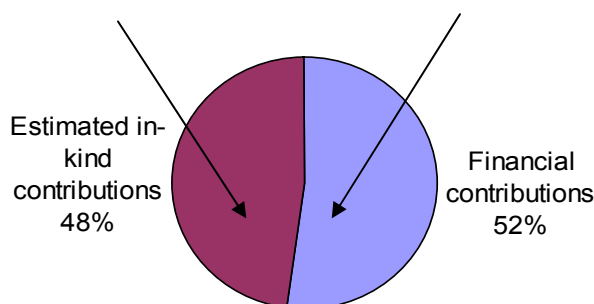
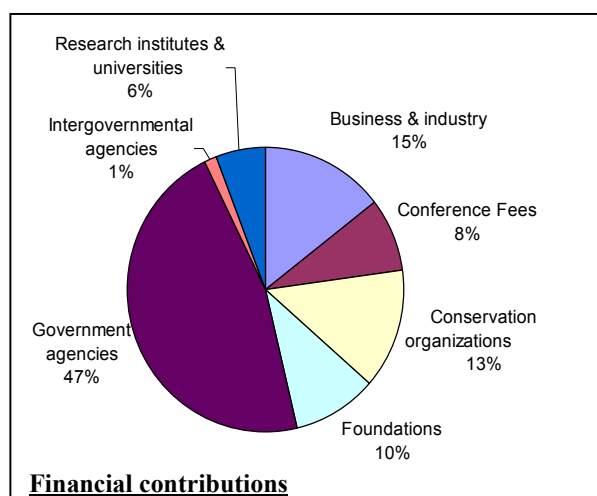
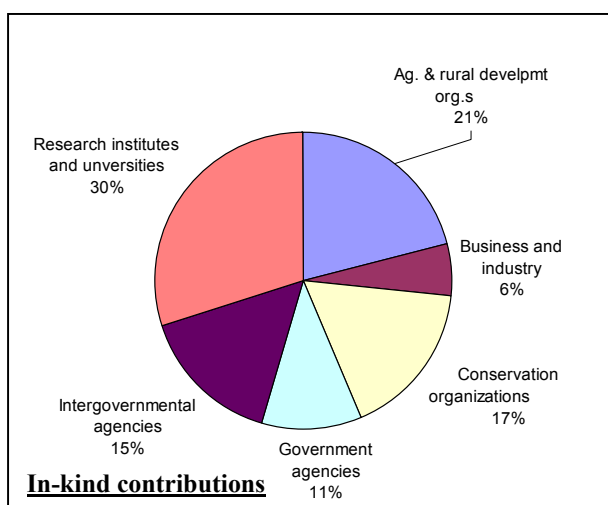
